# Goal 3—College, Career, Military Readiness

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## Goal 3: CCMR District Progress Measure 1

- The percent of CCMR students that met criterion on an AP examination will increase from 32% to 40% by August 2024.

## Goal 3: CCMR District Progress Measure 2

- The percent of CCMR students that meet the threshold for passing dual credit courses will increase from 17% to 29% by August 2024.

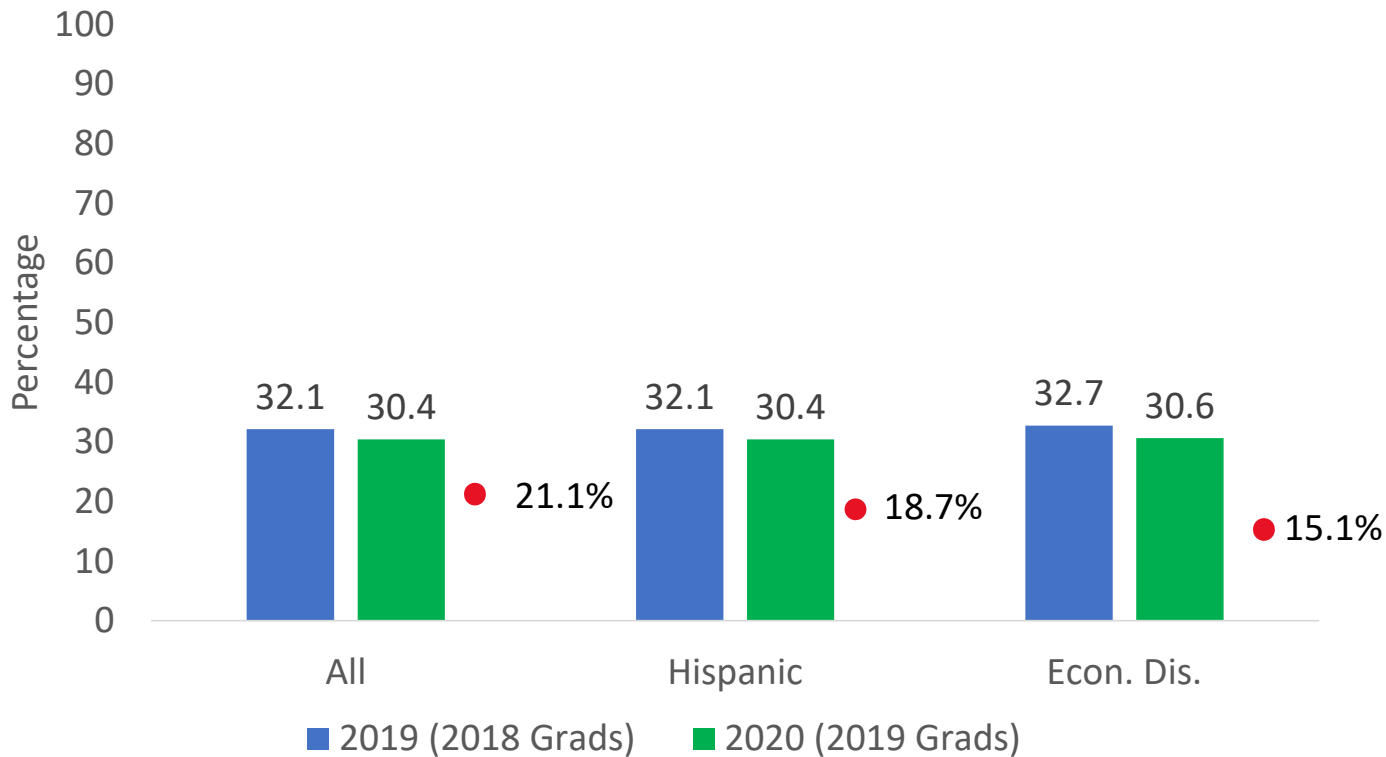
## Goal 3: CCMR District Progress Measure 3

- The percent of CCMR students that meet the threshold for CTE coherent sequence coursework aligned with industry certification will increase from 23% to 31% by August 2024.



## RYSS Goal 3 Progress Measure 1 Percentage of Graduates Scoring a 3 or Higher on Advanced Placement Exams

CCMR - Advanced Placement



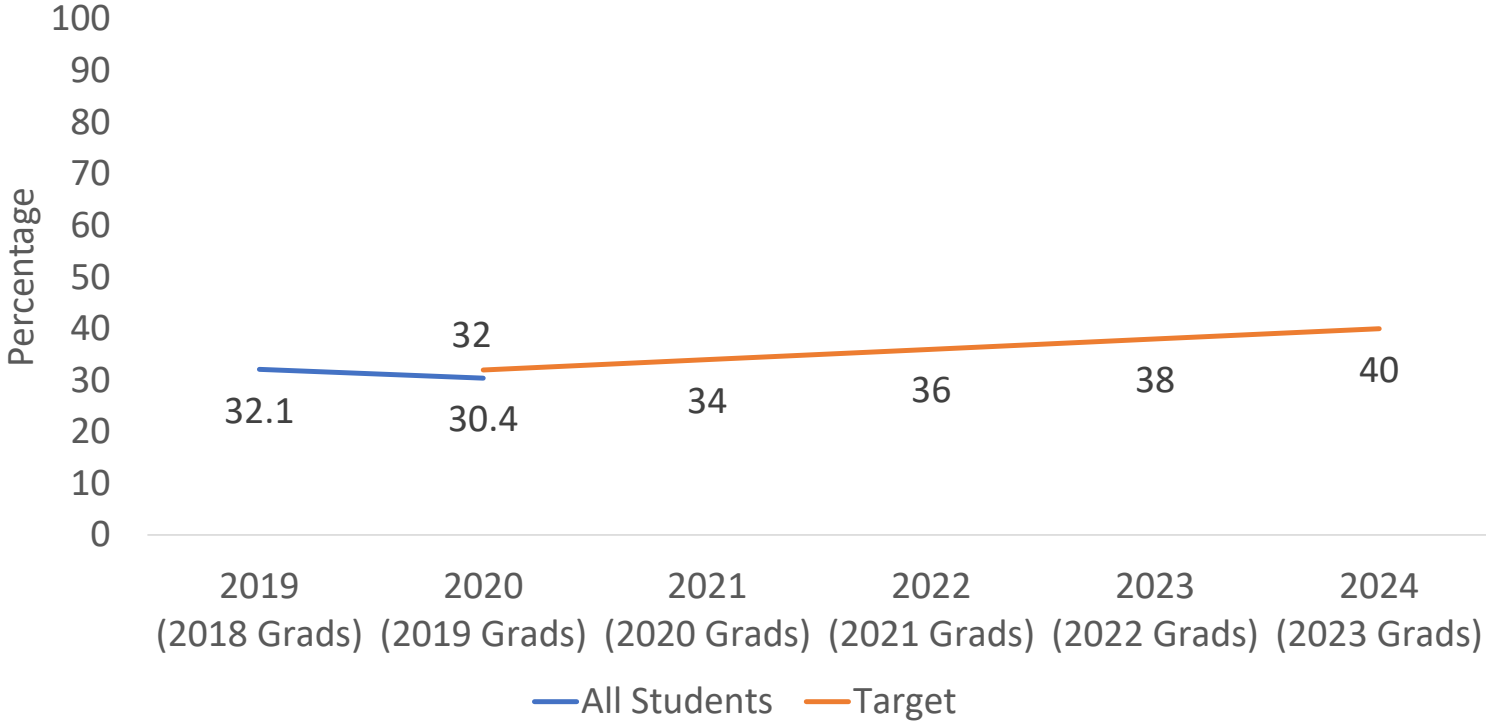
- Slight decrease for the 2019 graduates scoring a 3 or higher on any Advanced Placement exam than for 2018 graduates.
- RYSS 2019 graduates exceeded the state rates of 21.1%, 18.7%, and 15.1%.
- Class of 2020 results will be available summer 2021.

CCMR - Advanced Placement

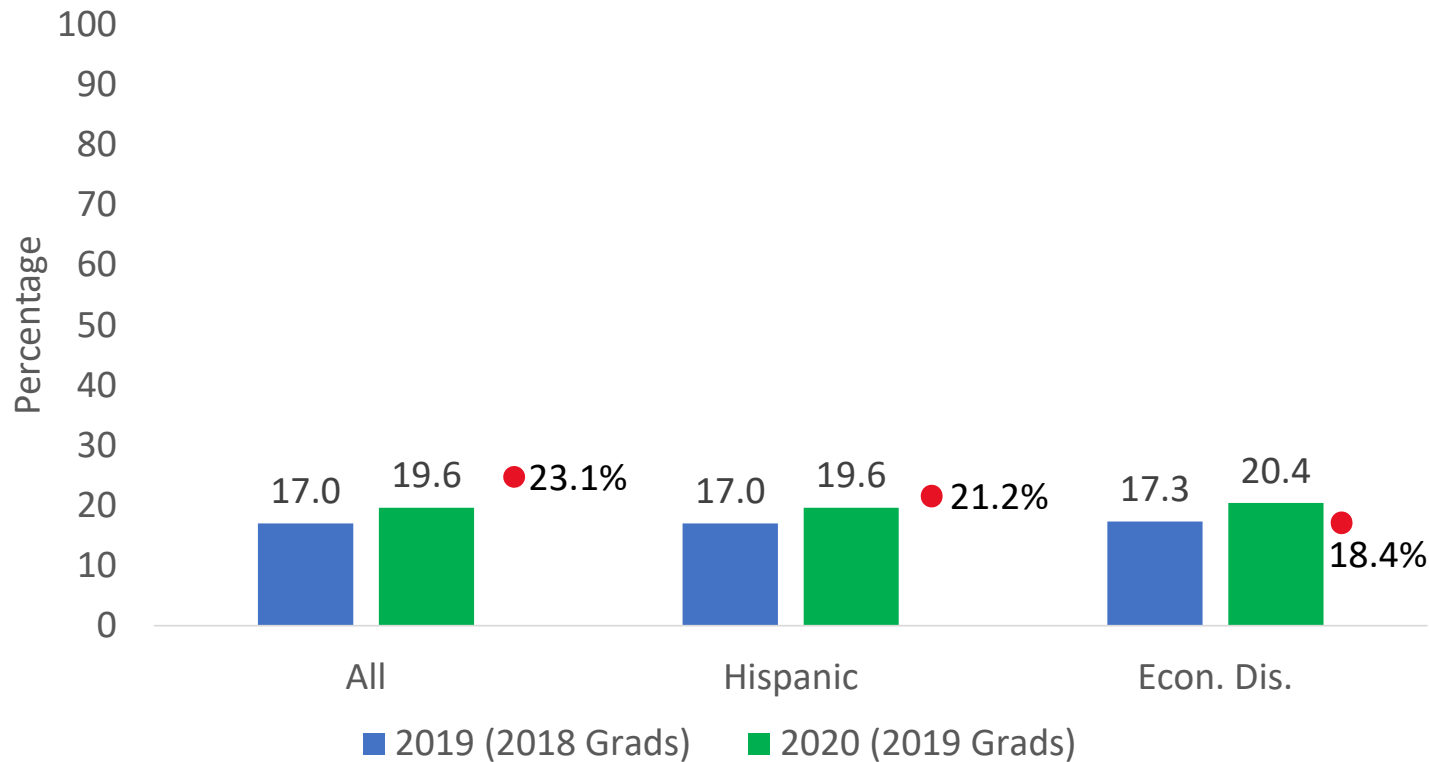


- Did not meet 2020 target for 2019 graduates.

CCMR - Dual Credit

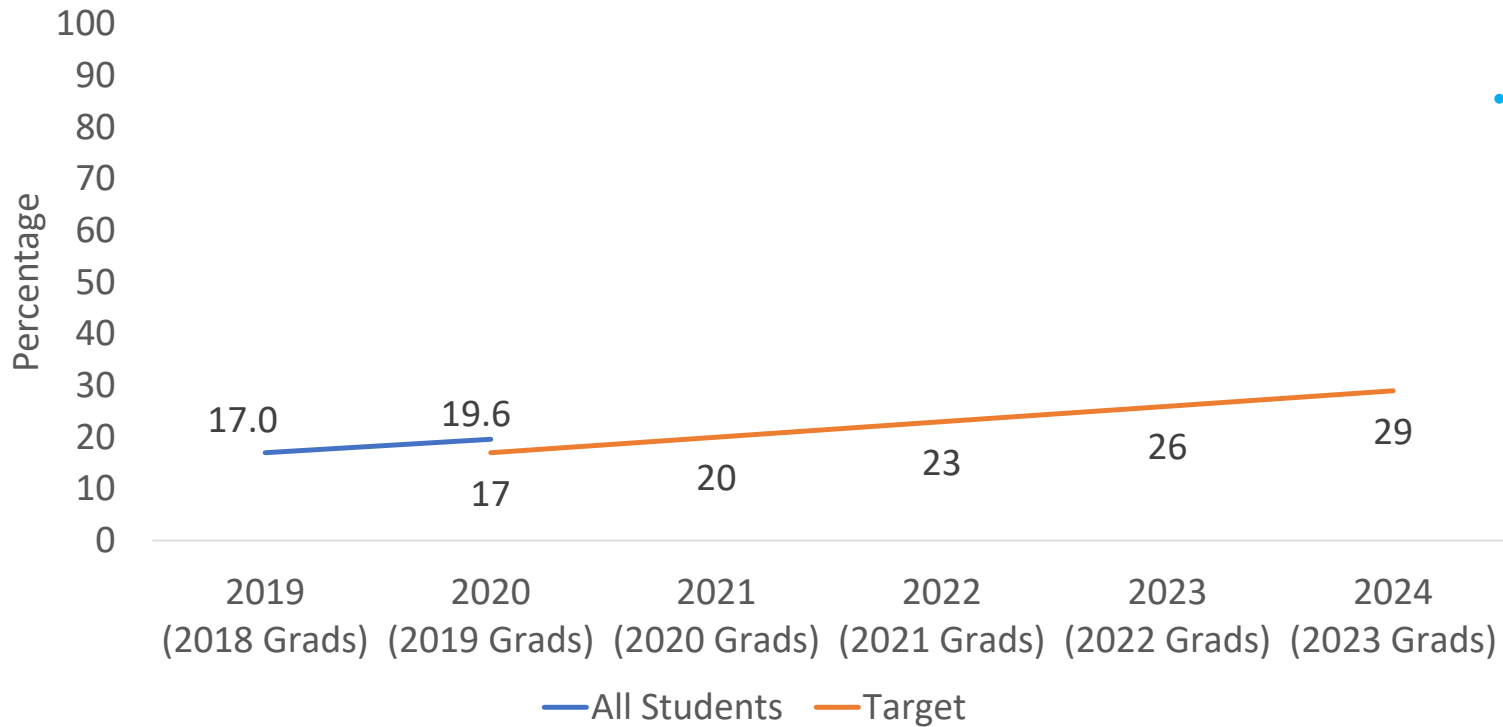


- Increase for the 2019 graduates earning dual credit than for 2018 graduates.
- RYSS 2019 graduates exceeded the state rate of 18.4% for economically disadvantaged students.
- Class of 2020 results will be available summer 2021.

CCMR - Dual Credit

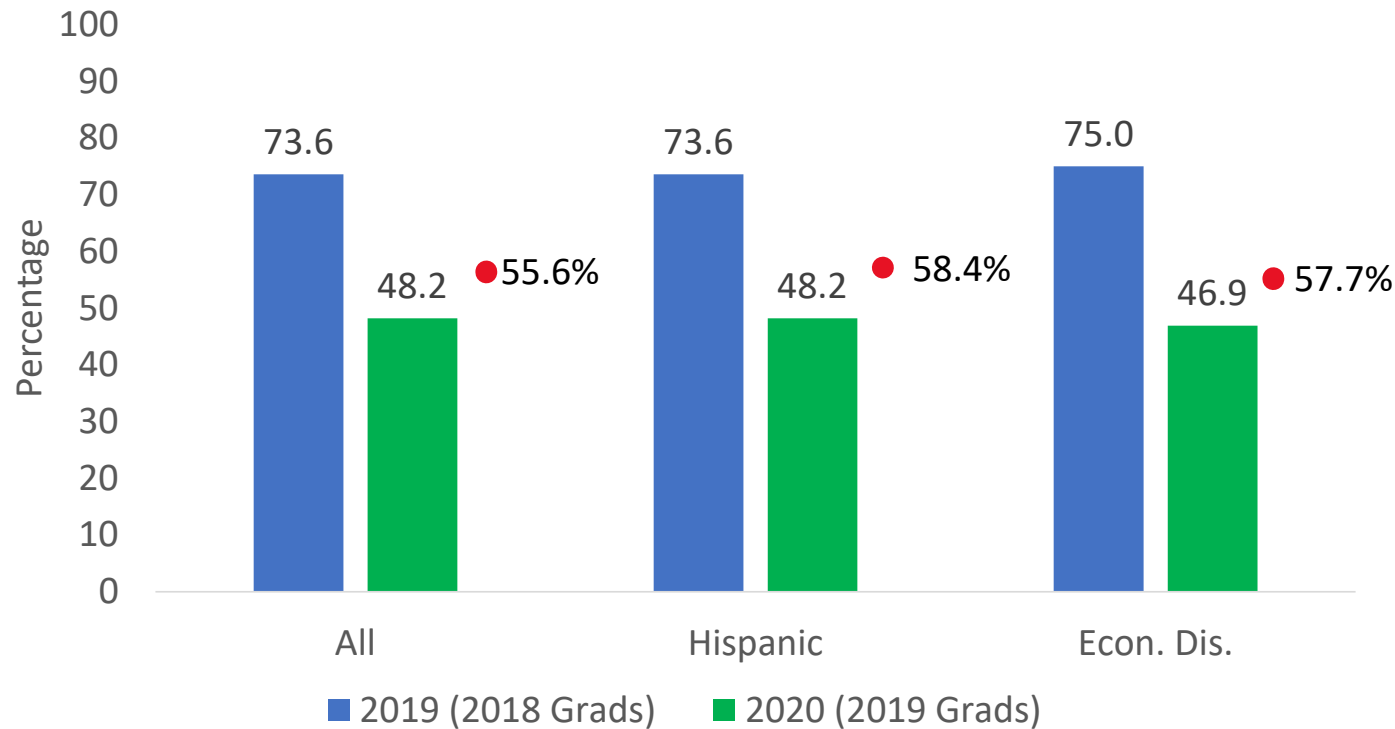


- Met 2020 target for 2019 graduates.

CCMR - Coherent Sequence Coursework

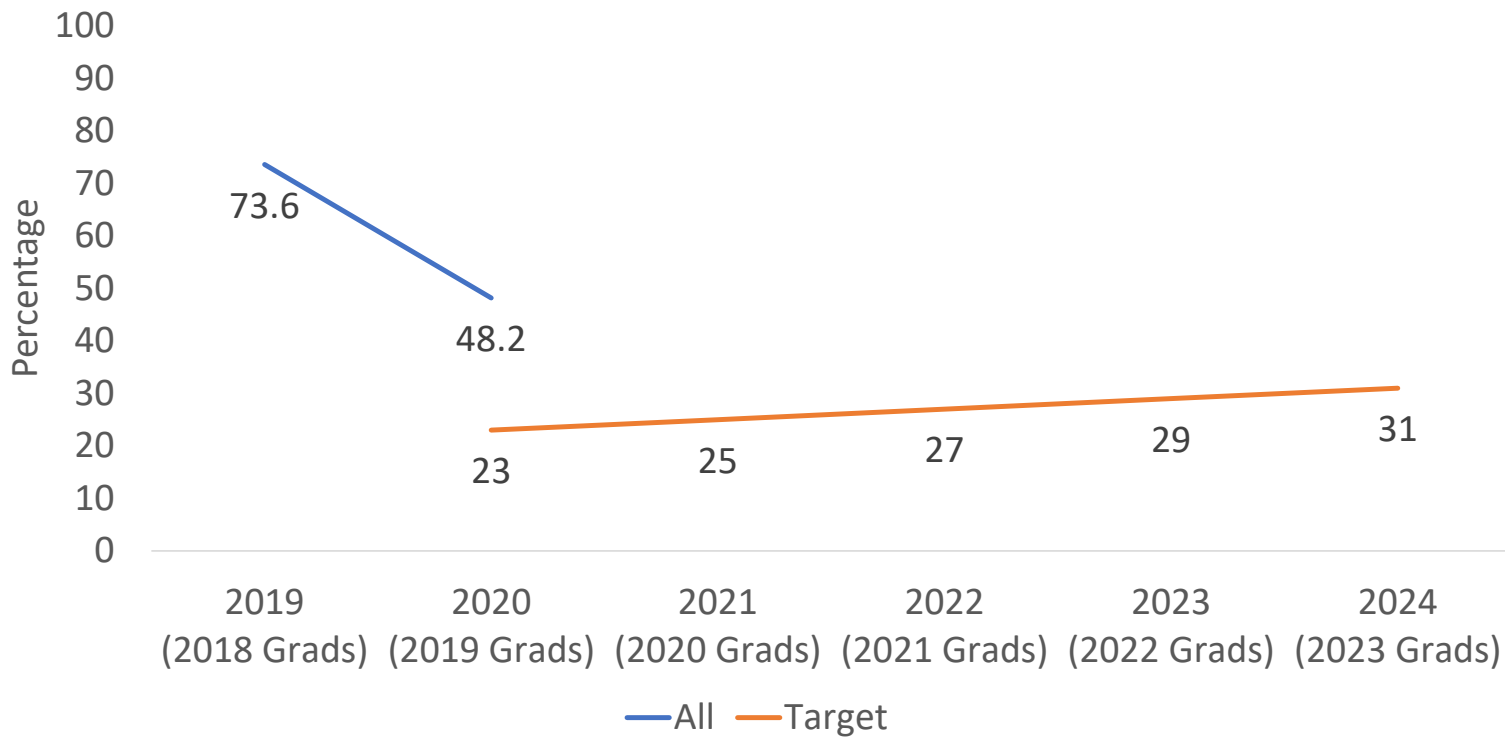


- Substantial decrease for the 2019 graduates completing CTE coherent coursework than for 2018 graduates.
- RYSS 2019 graduates had lower completion rates than the state for all three groups.
- Class of 2020 results will be available summer 2021.

## District Response to Data: 2020-2021 CCMR Strategies

- Increased the number of students receiving Dual Credit with HCC
  - P-Tech/Dual credit has increased number of course offerings by 6 new classes.
- Increased the AP Spanish Language exams by 30 students
- Increased the AP exam participation
- Increased number of students receiving Industry-based Certification credit
- Senior conferences were conducted for all seniors by the counselor and the senior teachers to ensure all seniors were in the appropriate pathways in September and in January.
- Two students were enlisted into the military.
- P-TECH Pharmacy Tech program was approved by the State CTE program in a partnership with HCC. It will be starting in the fall 2021 and will include Dual Credit and industry-based certification. 25 students will be in enrolled in the new program.
- 100 % of our 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade students took the SAT in the fall 2020 and received financial reimbursement for testing costs (state funding).
