

Goal 1—Early Childhood Reading


Goal 1: Early Childhood Reading District Progress Measure 2

The percent of students in Grade 1 that score on grade level on the TPRITejas Lee will increase from 48% to 76% by June 2025.

Goal 1: Early Childhood Reading District Progress Measure 3


The percent of Grade 2 students that score on grade level on TPRI-Tejas Lee Reading will increase from 57% to 85% by June 2025.

Progress Measure 2: Grade 1 TPRI Early Reading Assessment (TPRI/TL) Percentage at or Above Meets Grade Level Standard



- This year's first grade students improved their reading performance from the beginning of the year by 26 percentage points at BRYSS and 29 percentage points at PSTEM.
- The district's 2022 first grade EOY results matched the 2021 first grade results and therefore fell short of the 2022 target of 55%.

Progress Measure 3: Grade 2 TPRI Early Reading Assessment (TPRI/TL) Percentage at or Above Meets Grade Level Standard



- Current second grade students at BRYSS increased 43 percentage points from the beginning of the year.
- Second graders at PSTEM improved in reading by 25 percentage points but are still performing lower than 2021 second graders.
- 56% of 2022 district second graders performed at the Meets Grade Level Standard in reading and failed to meet the 2022 target of 64%.

District Response to Data: Reading Language Arts Strategies

- Establish RLA goals to focus on learning within RYSS Vertical Content Teams.
- Continue 120 min Reading block embedding writing processes
- Continuous PD offerings for teachers in using Pearson: My View, Mi Vision
- Fundamental Daily review: Phonics, Convention, High Frequency Words
- Small group interventions (Teacher Assistants providing support)
- Weekly High Frequency Word (HFW) & Reading Record assessment

Goal 2—Early Childhood Mathematics


Goal 2: Early Childhood Math District Progress Measure 1

The percent of Grade 1 students that score on grade level on Renaissance 360 will increase from 6% to 63% by June 2025.

Goal 2: Early Childhood Math District Progress Measure 2


➤ The percent of Grade 2 students that score on grade level on Renaissance 360 will increase from 10% to 65% by June 2025.

RYSS Renaissance 360 Mathematics Percentage at Meets or Above Grade Level



- This year's first grade students improved their math performance from the beginning of the year by 13 percentage points at BRYSS and 4 percentage points at PSTEM.
- The district's 2022 first grade EOY results exceeded the 2021 first grade results but fell short of the 2022 target of 21%.

- This year's second grade students improved their math performance from the beginning of the year by 12 percentage points at BRYSS and 2 percentage points at PSTEM.
- The district's 2022 second grade EOY results exceeded the 2021 second grade results but fell short of the 2022 target of 24%.

District Response to Data: Mathematics Strategies

- Establish math goals to focus on learning within RYSS Vertical Content Teams.
- Implement tasks that promote reasoning and problem-solving via Carnegie and Eureka Math
- Connect mathematical representations and foster meaningful mathematical discourse.
- Build procedural fluency and productive struggle from conceptual understanding
- Elicit and use evidence of student thinking via interactive notebooks.
